
# **Exam Results 2022: Headlines**

#### The Headlines

- 50% of the entries in GCSE English got a grade of 4 or above (44% in 2021)
- 40% of the entries in GCSE Maths got a grade of 4 or above
- 2 students achieved a GCSE in Literature with one student achieving a grade 6
- . 30% of students (main cohort) achieved their MTG in both English and Maths
- 86% of the GCSE Art entries got a grade of 4 or above
- In Post 16 68% of students now have a GCSE in English at grades 9-4 and 63% now have a GCSE in Maths at grades 9-4
- One Post 16 student achieved an A Level in Physics

# Core Subjects Achieved by the Y11 Main Cohort:

- 95% of the Y11 Main Cohort achieved an English Qualification
- 95% of the Y11 Main Cohort achieved a Maths Qualification
- 41% of the Y11 Main Cohort achieved a Science Qualification

# Outcomes in 2022 (Main Year 11 Cohort- 40 students)

- 58% achieved 3+ Level 1 and Level 2 qualifications (9-1 grades)
- 25% achieved 5+ Level 1 and Level 2 qualifications (9-1 grades)
