- Appropriate procedures are adopted to monitor the successful application of this policy and associated procedures

The Governors and staff of Newhaven School are committed to playing an active role in the implementation of this statement of intent and arrangements and undertake to annually review and revise it in light of any changes in legislation, experience and other relevant developments.
